

Indiana County Accepting Emergency Shelter Project Proposals and Program Comments

The County of Indiana will conduct a public hearing on July 13, 2026 at 1:00 PM in the Indiana County Commissioners Hearing Room located at the Indiana County Courthouse at 825 Philadelphia Street in Indiana, Pennsylvania. This meeting is accessible to individuals with disabilities and/or for persons with Limited English Proficiency. The purpose of the public hearing is to provide interested agencies and citizens an opportunity to provide comments and/or project proposals for a 2026 Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) application. There are six eligible components for ESG funds rapid re-housing; street outreach; homelessness prevention; emergency shelter; HMIS and administrative costs. The Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development has set August 10, 2026 at 5:00 PM as the deadline for applications.

Indiana County anticipates submitting an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development for multiple activities. Indiana County will partner with the Indiana County Community Action Program (ICCAP) to provide ESG services. The County application proposal can be revised based on eligible requests from other agencies. All program proposals and comments for Indiana County's consideration must be submitted by July 13, 2026 by 1:00 PM which is the time of the scheduled public hearing.
